The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) utilizes a third-party testing provider, PSI Services, to administer all FAA written exams. PSI exams are available at a number of testing locations throughout the US and abroad and can be scheduled online. Many local flight schools or FBOs host testing centers so you may not have to travel very far. Locating a written testing center is accomplished as part of the test registration process.

The first step to scheduling your FAA written exam is to visit <u>https://faa.psiexams.com/faa/login</u>. First time users will be required to create an account. You may also review <u>exam eligibility requirements</u> from the link on the homepage.

If you received training from any other source (ground-school classes from a non-Part 141 school, independent ground or flight instructor, or home-study course), you will need an appropriate endorsement for that test from the instructor who delivered the course.
